A Bylaw to Repeal Bylaw #104

Title

This bylaw may be cited as the Unsightly Properties Repeal Bylaw.

WHEREAS the Community of Murray Harbour has an unsightly properties bylaw in force in the community, Unsightly Properties Bylaw 104, originally passed by Council on June 3, 1998; and

WHEREAS the Murray Harbour Community Council sees it fit to repeal that bylaw;

THEREFOR be it enacted under authority of the *Municipalities Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-13* that the Community of Murray Harbour Unsightly Properties Bylaw, and all amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.
