Authorization to obtain a liquor license for the Murray Harbour Community Centre

WHEREAS the Council of Murray Harbour traditionally did not allow for alcoholic beverages to be sold or consumed on site at the Murray Harbour Community Centre.

WHEREAS it was expressed by the residents present at the March 2016 Annual General Meeting that this tradition be reversed to allow sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on said premises.

WHEREAS a motion was put forward by Council at the 2016 Annual General Meeting that the sale of alcoholic beverages be allowed in order to achieve higher revenues from special events held at the Community Centre, and that said motion was unanimously carried.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Administration for the Community of Murray Harbour, may from this point on, from time to time obtain a “Special Occasion” liquor license whenever needed, thus allowing for alcoholic beverages to be sold on its premises.

AND FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a permanent liquor license may also be obtained if Council wishes to do so in the future.
