Outdoor recreational spaces and activities will resume in Murray Harbour on June 4, 2020 using the following procedures and protocols.

**** There will be no public access to washroom or kitchen facilities until the Community Centre re-opens. ****

1. Gatherings and Social Distancing

Residents are encouraged to **maintain physical distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) between members of different households** at all times in public outdoor spaces, including the outdoor rink area, dog park, and playground.

Outdoor gatherings are limited to **20 people**.

General Guidelines:

- Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer often
- Cough/sneeze into your elbow or tissue
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with your hands
- Please stay at home if you're not feeling well or have any of the following symptoms:
 - cough (new or exacerbated chronic)
 - sneezing
 - headache
 - congestion
 - fever/chills
 - body aches
 - sore throat
 - runny nose
 - marked fatigue

2. Use of Shared Equipment

For Pickleball

- Shared equipment (racquets, balls, etc.) must be properly cleaned and disinfected after every use.
- Hand sanitizers and disinfecting solution will be made available in the storage area
- Access to the storage area will be limited to activity coordinators

For the Playground

- Parents are encouraged to sanitize their children's hands before and after they use the playground
- Parents must provide their own hand sanitizer or cleaning products.
- Common playground toys will not be provided

For the Dog Park

- Users are encouraged to sanitize their hands before and after touching gate latches, etc.
- Users must provide their own hand sanitizer or cleaning products.

This plan will be reviewed and adjusted as needed.
