5. New Business

a. <u>Discussion of the Grant for Renovations to the Community Centre and costs involved.</u> – Cllr. Pam Oickle and Anne Harnesk

Discussion regarding the misinformation we received from the province with respect to how much of the Community Centre Improvement project the CCBF would cover. For this project CCBF will not cover any of the costs involved in the kitchen reno. This leaves the village responsible for approximately \$20,000. We do have a bit of surplus in the

account, however, there is a possibility of going into the overdraft by approximately \$5,000. Discussion regarding risk vs. reward followed.

Moved by Cllr. Pam Oickle and seconded by Cllr. White

that Council approve proceeding with the Rural Growth initiative grant for renovations to the Community Centre in conjunction with the CCBF program. Council understands the Village will be responsible for approximately \$20,000 which may result in the Village using approximately \$5,000 from the overdraft funds.
